

EPS 2023 conference on High Energy Physics

Hamburg, March 2023

Dear colleague,

The EPS 2023 conference on high energy physics will take place from Monday, August 21, to Friday August 25, in Hamburg, Germany. The conference will be hosted jointly by the Universität Hamburg and the Deutsches Elektronen Synchrotron, DESY.

After the purely online version of the 2021 version of this conference, this will be again an in-person conference. We are very much looking forward to welcoming many of you to Hamburg for a lively and interesting conference on the latest developments in particle and astro-particle physics and related areas. The conference will offer a mixture of plenary sessions, with high-profile keynote speakers presenting the latest results in the field, and parallel sessions and a poster session to discuss in details latest results.

The conference Web site <http://www.eps-hep2023.eu> is open and the registration to the event is possible. While plenary talks are by invitation only, you are encouraged to submit presentations to the parallel sessions and to the poster sessions.

Major deadlines for the conference are:

- End of early registration at a reduced fee: May 30, 2023
- End of registration: August 1, 2023 (after this date, late registrations at an increased fee will still be possible though will require moderation)
- End of abstract submission: June 1, 2023: We intend to inform speakers of accepted talks by June 20, 2023

For people unable to travel to Hamburg for the conference we will offer the possibility to attend the conference online. Plenary sessions will be web-cast and recorded versions of the talks will be – pending permission by the speaker – available for some period after the conference. Parallel sessions will be available through zoom sessions, though we will not be able to guarantee high quality video for all parallel sessions at the same time. Zoom links will only be provided to registered participants.

The registration fee for the conference is as follows:

Standard registration fee:	450 EUR (550 EUR after May 30)
Reduced registration fee:	250 EUR (300 EUR after May 30)
Standard online early registration fee:	125 EUR (175 after May 30)
Reduced online early registration fee:	75 EUR (100 EUR after May 30)

Regular Registration closes on August 1, after this, onsite registration at a fee of 600 EUR is available.

The reduced fee applies to undergraduate and graduate students (proof required). Payment of the fee is possible online or by bank transfer. Cash payment will be possible once you arrive at the conference, but please be prepared for some waiting time – we strongly propose that you use one of the online payment options.

Technical information for attending the EPS 2023 conference in Hamburg

The conference will take place downtown Hamburg, on the site of the Universität Hamburg. The campus is located close to major main-line train stations, and within walking distance to the central shopping and touristic district of the city of Hamburg. It is easily reached from the Hamburg airport, with a sub-way train going directly to the airport.

The conference venue will be the van-Melle Park Campus of the university, with all rooms and lecture halls within a few minutes of each other.

Hamburg offers a wide variety of lodging options for travelers, with many hotels close to the location of the conference. We encourage participants to the conference to book their rooms early, to secure good deals. Hamburg is a very popular tourist location during summer, and accommodations might become crowded.

Hamburg is served by major airlines, with the main airport about a 40min subway ride away, is well integrated into the network of high-speed trains in Germany, and well served by major autoroutes. Within the city, getting around by public transport is easy, with a closely-knit network of subways (called S-Bahn and U-Bahn), busses and even boats making every part of the city easily accessible.

If you intend to bring your partner or family members to Hamburg to accompany you, please note that all social events organized during the conference are open to partners, with the exception of the dinner, free of charge. We do not offer a special program for accompanying persons during the conference, but the conference secretariat will be happy to help you with information about the city and events in the city during the days of the conference.
